ANATOMY

- 1. The brain is the central organ of the nervous system.
- 2. The brain is divided into three main parts: the cerebrum, cerebellum, and brainstem.
- 3. The cerebrum is the largest part of the brain and is responsible for higher-level functions such as thought, memory, and emotion.
- 4. The cerebellum is located at the back and bottom of the brain and is responsible for coordination and balance.
