

RESEARCH AND ANALYSIS: THE RESEARCH PROCESS

1. The research process is a series of steps that lead to the discovery of new knowledge.

RESEARCH PROCESS

1. Identify a research problem or question.

2. Review the literature to understand what is already known.

3. Formulate a hypothesis or research objectives.

4. Design the study.

5. Collect data.

6. Analyze the data to test the hypothesis or answer the research question.

7. Interpret the results.

8. Write a research report.

9. Present the findings at a conference or in a journal.

10. Use the findings to inform practice or policy.

11. Repeat the process as needed to refine the findings.

12. Share the findings with the research community.
