Dee Zee Molded Mud Flap Installation Instructions

3M Protective Film Installation:

Dee Zee mudflaps are designed to fit snugly into the wheel well. To protect your vehicle, Dee Zee has included a 3M protective film.

- 1) Hold the mudflap up to wheel well to determine 3M protective film placement.
- 2) Thoroughly clean the area where the film is to be installed using 3M brand adhesive cleaner or other petroleum distillate based cleaner.
- 3) Cut the film to the proper shape for your application
- 4) Mix a solution of water and dishwasher detergent into a spray bottle.
- 5) Remove film from the protective liner and spray with the water solution.
- 6) Apply the film to the fender, adhesive side down and spray total area with water solution
- 7) Remove any air bubbles in film using a wet sponge.

Mudflap installation:

- 1) Place the mudflap up to the wheel well and use the existing holes in the mudflap as a guide to center punch and mark the mounting holes on the fender well. Drill 1/8" holes for each location
- 2) Now secure the mudflap to the wheel well using the #8 x 3/4" Phillips head screws. Tighten into place using a short Phillips head screwdriver. On flare side models S-clips may have to be installed behind flare in order for the screws to secure.
